



# B ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE


- Construction contractors bid on project early fall 2024

- Construction end and Blue Line opening anticipated 2027/2028








### Single bi-directional lane






Ritter Station Location

Moved to West Leg of Intersection








### **PROJECT BUDGET & FUNDING:**

- \$370 \$390M
  - No change


### **FUNDING:**

- FTA Small Starts Grant: \$150M
- RAISE Grant: \$21.8M
  - New in 2024
- Community Project Funding: \$1.0M
  - New in 2024
- DPW Contribution: \$16.5M
- CEG Contribution: \$15.0M
- Additional federal funds: \$36M
- Local Match: \$135M



### RAISE Grant

- Rebuilding American infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE)
- Competitive grant
- IndyGo awarded \$21.8M in 2024 to fund modernization and safety of Washington Street
- Project completed in conjunction with the Blue Line



- Project area: Highland Ave to Edmondson Ave (approx.)
- Project information:
  - Roadway lane reconfiguration
  - Dedicated BRT lanes
  - SOGR maintenance for sidewalks, street and pedestrian markings, ADA ramps
  - Signage and wayfinding;
  - Transit signal priority (TSP) and new traffic signals;
  - Better crosswalk markings and beacons

# ES STATUS



### **CURRENT STATUS:**

- 100% design complete
- Right-of-way acquisition in progress

### **TIMELINE:**

- FTA Grant Agreement -> TBD 2024/2025
- Procurement -> Fall 2024
- Construction Start -> Early 2025
- Construction End & Blue Line Open -> 2027/2028
